

## Chris Young Taking Stage at Hard Rock

Fans can catch one of country music's biggest stars in Atlantic City.

Chris Young, who's had two consecutive studio albums debut on top of Billboard's Country Albums Chart, will be playing the Hard Rock Hotel & Casino Saturday, July 21. Only 33, Young was recently inducted into the Grand Ole Opry in Nashville. His stop at the Hard Rock is part of the *Chris Young Losing Sleep 2018 World Tour*, which has him appearing at more than 40 venues in the U.S. and Canada.

Young plays the Innsbrook Pavilion in Virginia July 20.

After winning the USA Network's, *Nashville Star*, in 2006, Young signed with RCA Records Nashville. His first album - released in 2006 - had a pair of singles on Hot Country Songs. In 2009, Young released his second record, *The Man I Want to Be*. The album's title track as well as two other singles, *Voices*, and, *Gettin' You Home*, were best-sellers.

Young's third release, *Neon*, featured the top-selling hits, *Tomorrow*, and, *You*.

*A.M.*, released in 2013, included three singles - *Aw Naw*, *Who I Am with You*, and *Lonely Eyes* - that climbed the charts.

Young, a Tennessee native, released his fifth album, *I'm Comin' Over*, in 2015. The record collected several ACM, BBMA, CMA, CMT, Grammy and RDMA nominations and had three singles reach No. 1.

*It Must Be Christmas*, Young's sixth studio album, came out in October 2016.

Last year, his seventh record, *Losing Sleep*, was his second straight release to debut at the top of Billboard's Country Albums Chart.

Vince Gill invited Young to become a member of the Opry on August 29, 2017. He was later inducted by Brad Paisley.

Notable stops on the current tour include Tulsa, Biloxi, Nashville, Greensboro, Philadelphia, Tampa, Milwaukee, Detroit, Baltimore and PNC Arena in Raleigh. Among other performers featured along the way are Dan + Shay, Morgan Evans, and Dee Jay Silver.
